691 quilts were donated in 2019,
bringing the total since inception to 8004 donated.
We have 83 finished tops ready to be quilted and
260 kits waiting to become quilt tops.

When:

Next Bee Thursday February 6

If you bring your sewing machine there are quilt kits waiting to become quilt tops, binding and labeling.

QUILT SIZES: AZ Blanket 4 Kids requested that we make our teen quilts larger.

These size are approximate:

Small – Toddlers & Infants up to 40 X 40

Medium – Child 40 X 48

Large – Older Child 40 X 55to 60

Extra Large – Teen 50 X or wider to 60 X 70

We are really short on small and extra large quilt tops, but all tops are welcome on our shelves. If you have any questions,
