

Diamond in the Nine

This pattern can be made using scraps of fabric or using a planned color scheme as shown in the diagram below.

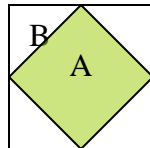
Fabric Requirements

- Fabric A - 1 strip 6 x WOF
- Fabric B - 1/3 yard (12 inches)
- Fabric C - 3/4 yard (26 inches)
- Fabric D - 1/2 yard (14 inches)
- Fabric E - 1/3 yard (10 inches)
- Fabric F - 1/2 yard (18 inches)

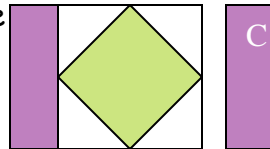
Cutting Instructions for the blocks

- A - Cut 6 - 6 inch squares
- B - Cut 12 - 5 1/2 squares (cut diagonally)
- C - Cut 24 - 4 1/2 x 8 1/2 rectangles
- D - Cut 24 - 4 1/2 squares
- E - Cut 4 - 2 1/2 x WOF strips
(subcut 3pcs 2 1/2 x 16 1/2 for short sashing)
- F - 5 - 3 1/2 inch strips (borders)

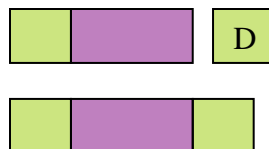
1. Sew the long side of each triangle to the sides of the center square. This will create a diamond in a square design as shown.



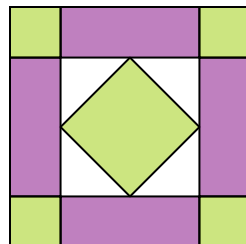
2. Sew a 4 1/2 x 8 1/2 rectangle to opposite sides of your diamond in a square as shown in the diagram.



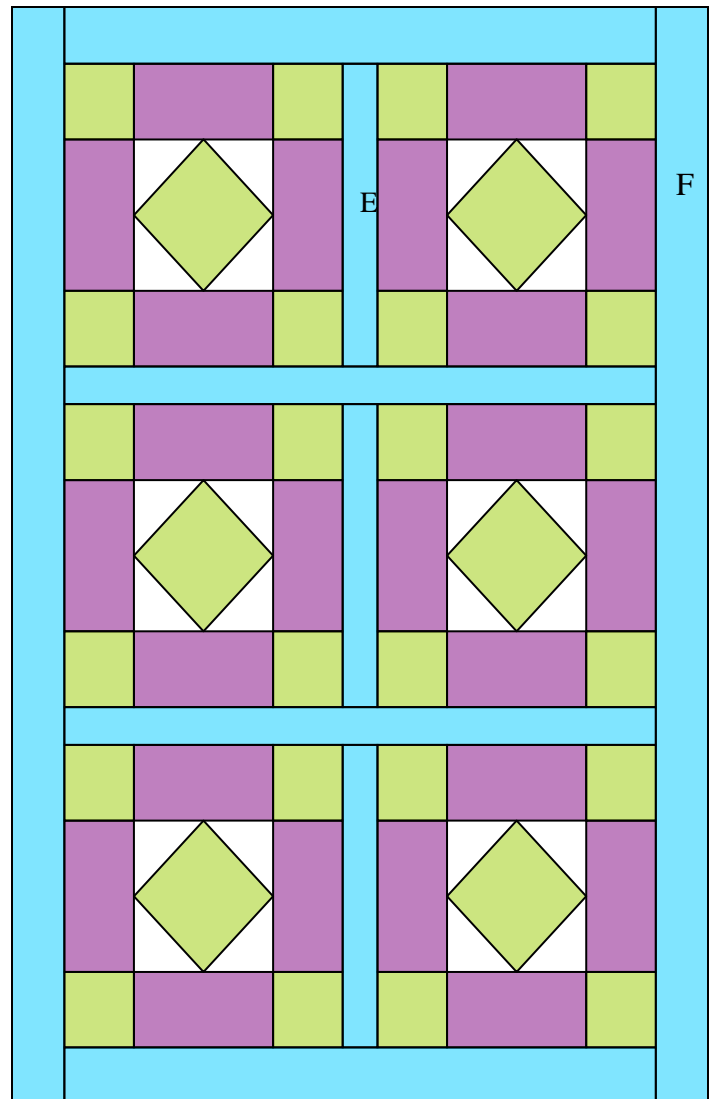
3. Sew the 4 - 4 1/2 squares to each end of the 2 remaining rectangles as shown in the diagram.



4. Sew all components together to create six 16 1/2 inch blocks like the one in the diagram.



5. Sew the blocks, sashing, and borders together to create a quilt top like the diagram.
